

Recording Options



Direct to Computer

PC: RecordPad

Mac: Garage Band



Digital Voice Recorder

Copy files to computer

Tape Recorder

Plug into computer's Audio In port





Recording Tips

* Minimize background noise

Use a "unidirectional" microphone or "dictation mode" on digital voice recorder

- * Make test recordings
 to learn where to place the microphone
- * Pause for a few seconds of silence before and after speaking; do not touch recorder while speaking
- * Pause after making a mistake, to allow for editing

Editing

- * Software
 - PC: WavePad
 - Mac: Garage Band
- * Trim to start and end of program
- * Cut out mistakes
- * Use vocal presets to reduce noise (Mac)

Converting

- * Many proprietary recording formats
- * Publish in MP3 format
- * Software
 - PC: WavePad, or Switch for batch work
 - Mac:
 - .wma to .mp3 \Rightarrow QuickTime Pro + Flip4Mac
 - all others to .mp3 ⇒ Garage Band

Publish

- * iPod
 - Import into iTunes
 - Share from Garage Band
- * Other MP3 players
 - Import into Windows Media Player (WMP)
- * CDs

Burn CD from iTunes or WMP

Publish

- * Email
 - MP3 files are too large to email
- * Web
 - Upload to <u>www.zendu.org</u>
 - From there, can download to iTunes, WMP
